Biography

CW5 Wade H. Lovorn III is currently assigned to the Combined Arms Command, Center for Army Leadership as a Leader Development Officer. He also performs duties as the Senior Warrant Officer Advisor to the Commanding General and Chairman of the Senior Warrant Officer Advisory Council (SWOAC). His previous assignment was with the U.S. Army Materiel Command, Logistics Support Activity as the Officer in Charge and Chief of Operations for the Corps/Theater Automated Data Processing Center (CTASC) at Redstone Arsenal, Alabama. He led the effort in the collocation of all the Army's ten CTASCs into one activity.

CW5 Lovorn joined the Army in 1981, attended Basic Training at Fort Dix immediately followed by training at Fort Rucker in the Initial Entry Rotary Wing (IERW) Aviation Course and Aero Scout Track. He earned his pilot's wings and was sent to Panama as a Utility Helicopter Pilot for his first assignment.

He was reclassified in 1984 into the Quartermaster Corps where he has since been serving as a Supply Systems Technician meeting the needs of the Army. His assignments have included divisional and non-divisional Supply Support Activities, commodity manager at Division and Corps Materiel Management Centers, Logistics Advisor to the Egyptian Air Force, Quartermaster Combat Developer, and CTASC systems administrator. These assignments have taken him to Germany, Egypt, Fort Lee, Fort Hood (four times), and Redstone Arsenal. CW5 Lovorn has deployed in support of Operation Desert Shield/Storm and Operation Iraqi Freedom.

CW5 Lovorn has completed all phases of the Warrant Officer Education System. His military schooling includes the Warrant Officer Candidate Development Course, IERW Aviation Course, Supply and Services Management Officer Course, Warrant Officer Aviation and Quartermaster Advance Courses, Warrant Officer Staff Course, The Army's Force Management Course, and Warrant Officer Senior Staff Course. He also holds a Bachelor's Degree in Liberal Studies from the State University of New York.

His awards and decorations include, the Bronze Star (oak leaf cluster), Meritorious Service Medal (seven oak leaf clusters), Army Commendation Medal, Army Achievement Medal (oak leaf cluster), National Defense Service Medal (bronze star), Southwest Asia Service Medal (two bronze stars), Global War on Terrorism Expeditionary Medal, Global War on Terrorism Service Medal, Kuwait Liberation Medal (Saudi Arabia), Kuwait Liberation Medal (Kuwait), and the Army Aviator's Badge.

CW5 Lovorn and his wife, Sherry are parents of four adult sons, Wade, Charles, Raymond, and James. They also have five grandchildren. CW5 Wade and Sherry Lovorn have been married for 33 years.
